Answers to frequently asked questions (FAQs) regarding garage sales.

GARAGE SALES AND SIGNS

Are there rules for garage sales?

Every property may have up to four garage sales, or similar, annually. Sales may last up to three days and operate between 8 a.m. and 9 p.m. Items that may be sold or exchanged include any personal property that was not purchased for the purpose of resale, including general household goods, used clothing, appliances and furniture.

Where can I put my signs?

Signs identifying the location and time of the sale may be placed on the property where the sale is located and on the private property of others with their consent.



Signs may not exceed 4 sq. ft. in area and cannot be placed on public property, including boulevards, or attached to any utility pole or other public sign; however, signs may be placed in the public right-of-way that are maintained by the owner or occupant of the residential property abutting said right-of-way. Sale signs must be removed within 24 hours after the sale has ended.

Is there anything else I need to know?

City ordinances prohibit the storage of junk, garbage, appliances, debris and all household items outside. Residents are responsible for appropriately disposing of unwanted items following each sale.
